Sherri Merritt-Thayne Ambulance

- Sherri stated that she would like to excuse rest of her board as they had other commitments. Sherri wanted to follow up with what has been happening since we met last. For 2017 Thayne EMS had 205 page outs which include car accidents, transports to the hospital and fire standbys. Sherri stated that the Ambulance service might have a few people interested in taking the EMT basic class that is starting Monday January 22, 2018. Thayne EMS also had a meeting with dispatch and the other different agencies. Search and Rescue was involved with that and made the comment that if Thayne Ambulance ever needed to go out with them on a search that they would need the

proper winter attire. Sherri wanted to make us aware that they might be making a purchase to make sure some of the EMT's have the proper winter gear.

- Mayor Lainhart advised Sherri that SVR Mayor Buyers is still out of town for another three weeks and until she gets back we will not be moving forward with the hospital board.
- Mayor Lainhart wanted to share a problem that the Town of Thayne has run into. As a result of the request made by one of the EMS regarding W2 status the town has been contacted by the Department of Workforce Service. There has been some discussion on what is considered a volunteer. As of now, if any EMT receives money they are not considered a volunteer.

Sunrise Engineering-Robert Hood

- Thayne Storage Tank Project
 - Robert stated that we have confirmation from Don Brown that he will sell the property to the Town of Thayne for the storage tank. Kevin Voyles is working on the details of the transaction. Robert stated that the geotechnical drilling was completed last week to test soils. Once the report is received we will begin the structural design of the tank. A 10% design meeting was held with WWDC project manager, Ken Mitchell. Recoating specs for the existing tank are about 75% complete however, old paint will need to be tested for lead.
- North Waterline Replacement Project Update
 - Kevin Voyles still working on finalizing easements.
 - Finding increase request to be considered by the SLIB on February 1, 2018
- Wright and Van Noy Sidewalks Project
 - Environmental Responses have been received, report is 90% complete
 - Survey is complete

Thayne Maintenance Report-Cliff Eggleston

- Work Order Tracker update
- Cliff stated he didn't have a lot per just having back surgery. He did state that there was a water leak in El Jean Estates. It was a service connection and he was able to get a contractor here to help us get that fixed.
- Mayor asked that Cliff to contact Rick and let him know that snow needs to be removed at the sewer facility. Mayor Lainhart also stated that the first priority for snow removal is the school and then community center.
- Cliff ended by stating he had a Doctor's appointment next Friday and was hoping to get a work release from the Doctor at that time.
